Free School Meals

Should your child be receiving Free School Meals?

We can help. If you think your family is eligible, complete the attached Free School Meals form and return to Ms Sillwood. We will apply to the Local Authority on your behalf and get an instant answer.

You can apply if you or your partner are in receipt of one of the following:

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Child Tax Credit provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs) that does not exceed £16,040. Parents receiving Working Tax Credit for four weeks after their employment finishes are entitled to free school meals during that period. This also applies to parents who start working less than 16 hours per week.

We have attached a form for your convenience the information and the form are also on our website.

Your child can have a healthy, nutritious meal at lunchtime, don't miss out.

Maths faculty

We are approaching a very busy exam period in May and June.

- **All** learners in year 11 are completing a GCSE in maths and/or statistics.
- **All** learners in year 10 are taking GCSE modules.
- **All** learners in 8X4 are taking their unit 2 GCSE exam.
- Year 12 A level students are sitting at least 2 modules to complete their AS
- Year 13 A level students are sitting at least 1 module to complete their A level.
- In addition, 8 year 11 learners are sitting the S1 A-level module

In order for learners to be prepared for these exams, they must ensure they:

- Have an exam timetable and KNOW the DATE and TIME of each exam - learners must NOT arrive late for any of their exams
- Have a scientific calculator for use in their exam
- Have the correct equipment ready for use in the exam
- Prepare and use a revision timetable
- Attend after school intervention (Wednesday 3.30-4.30) as well as any targeted intervention classes they are invited to (these may be during lesson time, after school or in the May half term)
- Use the topic list they have been given to help revise Practise as many exam questions as possible from revision guides, mymaths or websites recommended by their teachers.

Year 10 and 8X4 will have a mock practise paper under exam conditions on 23rd May to help prepare for their actual exam in June

Please remember that the following can be purchased from the maths department (at a lower cost than from the shops) if learners do not have them already:

PENCIL CASE EQUIPMENT SETS (£1)

- Long clear pencil case (suitable for use in exams)
- 30cm ruler
- Pair of compasses with pencil
- Protractor

- Eraser
- Pencil sharpener

SCIENTIFIC CALCULATORS (£5.50)

These are Fx83 Casio calculators which are the most suitable type for GCSE maths and can also be used for A-level. Learners MUST have a scientific calculator for lessons.

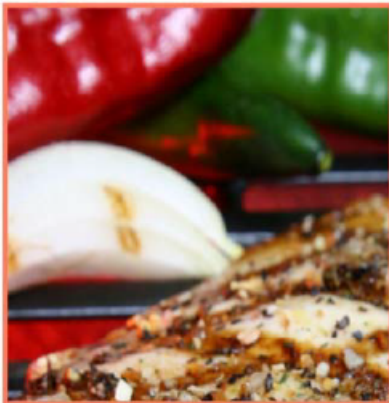
and finally.....
