Scott Williams, a New Zealander, was a former teacher and rugby coach at Harrow High School from 2002 to 2006. He died aged 35 in 2009.

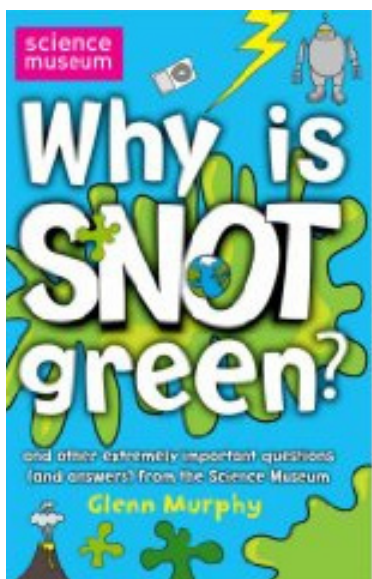
