

Over recent years, Harrow High Sixth Form has transformed into an outstanding Sixth Form. Our learners are happy, safe and enjoy learning, leading to rapid progress and excellent examination results. In August 2017, Harrow High Sixth Form learners achieved the best exam results ever at the school at A-Level and we are delighted with them.

At A-Level, 20% of A level grades were awarded at A*-A and 55% at A*-B. With Level 3 BTEC outcomes included, these figures are a staggering 38% and 72% respectively, with an amazing 90% of grades at A*-C. This places us in the top 10% of Sixth Forms nationally for AS level, A-Level, and BTEC qualifications.

As a result of the fantastic progress learners make in our Sixth Form, our students regularly progress to some of the best universities in the world such as Imperial, UCL, and Warwick. This emphasis on achievement is underpinned by our ethos of 'Excellence for All'. This means that at Harrow High Sixth Form we have the highest expectations of and aspirations for all of our learners. At the same time, we remain a small sixth form and we take time to get to know every learner properly. We provide personal support, careers guidance and tailored learning interventions to ensure each individual achieves their full potential and is happy, supported and successful in the Sixth Form and in their university applications.
